Communication and Information Systems (CIS) Requirements Branch

The CIS Requirements Branch is responsible for ensuring that MCC HQ Northwood is equipped with the CIS necessary to perform its mission. The Branch is responsible for CIS budgeting, planning and requirements specification. It provides timely and relevant advice to the planning and decision-making process in the HQ by ensuring that CIS issues are properly researched and analysed.

In addition, the Branch is responsible for the coordination of CIS training for all new core applications and services. The branch also contributes to the development of NATO CIS policy, doctrine and programs by collaborating with other HQs to provide HQ CIS inputs to directives, plans and other documents.

Finally, the Requirements Branch is responsible for the coordination and administration of INFOSEC issues, policy and accreditation both within the HQ and subordinate commands.


